





Introduction

East-West International School & College was established in 1995 with a vision to enhance the opportunities for English medium education. Its curriculum has been approved by the University of London. UK & Ministry of Education of the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh. EWIS&C is a non-profitable, non-commercial organization located at Shewrapara, Mirpur, Dhaka, and is a glaring manifestation of an orderly and congenial atmosphere under a dynamic management. A galaxy of highly energetic, young and well qualified teaching staff is fully devoted to educating the young learners, meeting the global need and at the same time fulfilling a long cherished dream of the surrounding areas.

The Campus

The campus is situated at House # 265/1, West Shewrapara, Mirpur, Dhaka-1216. The building is just close the Rokeya Shoroni. The campus offers healthy environment for an academic institution. Plenty of open spaces are available around the campus for the students to move about for rest and recreation.

Soon the school campus is going to be shifted to a new site close to the present campus. The school authority has already purchased a land measuring 34 – decimal at Shewrapara of Mirpur in Dhaka. The construction work of the new campus in a 10 storied unique building with all modern school facilities is expected to start very soon. After shifting the campus to the new place, the school is definitely going to be one of the leading schools of this kind both in quality and space.

The mission

The mission of East-West International School & College, as a high quality English Medium Institute, is to develop the students through appropriate and quality education and guidance for creative knowledge to prosecute higher studies maintaining an easy contact and relation with the world outside. It aims at achieving the following goals and its curriculum and syllabi have also been designed and formulated accordingly:

currents and crosscurrents of the economic, technological, cultural and political arenas is a must. The students of this institution will also be familiar with the importance of nature around us and the environment posing a threat to our planet with the problem of its ever growing population.

- iv. East-West International School & College is not contented with imparting the knowledge that is stereotyped and langsyne typed. Now English Medium School is worth its name that does not expand the frontiers of knowledge through sustained educational research. With the expansion of the school, we intend to gradually lay emphasis on research activities by both teachers and students. Further there are seminars, symposium and workshop arranged for developing the latent faculties of the students.
- v. The prime aim of East-West International School & College is to ensure quality education that will be disseminated through the best teachers trained at home and abroad, and we try to provide the education at a cost that our students can afford.
- vi. The struggle for existence is getting tougher and tougher every day. This is the time of competition in every sphere of life. That is why this institution educates the students for this

challenging society in which they must live, and provides them with adequate knowledge and power to change the society. Since we believe in free and liberal education, the students of East-West International School & College long for pursuing higher studies in the foreign countries like U.K., U.S.A, Canada, Australia under their own management after passing 'O' and 'A' Level examinations from this institution. The school authority is ready to extend all assistance in establishing contact with the foreign authorities concerned.

Teaching Method

Since it is well known to the staff of East-West International School & College that childhood is the most impressionable stage and anything good or bad taught to the children makes an indelible mark on their mind, East-West International School & College discards traditional system and introduces systematic and careful intensive Child Psycho-Therapy Development Program (CPTDP) that is bearing the sign of sincere efforts to overcome all sorts of disappointing atmosphere.

The young and innocent kids like other social beings are growing up and are not enjoying the same social benefit and rights as others in this mass complicated world. Parents being busy, most of the time they are unable to share filial feelings with their children. The well-trained and highly educated and dedicated teaching staff of East-West International School & College yield parental love to the young as the equal of parents. They also help them cultivate and enhance all human qualities.

The prime aim of the teachers is to give baby learners a preschool experience with a view to making them inclined to school life and feel it as their second home. At this stage the teacher plays the role of multiple personalities. When the young

learners feel home-sickness, the teachers play the role of parents. When they are in good mood, the teachers become their playmates. When they become restless and impatient, the teachers play the role of baby sitter. Classes from Play Group to KG-II are conducted by very resourceful and skilled teachers who take up the total responsibilities of the students including their day to day lesson preparations in the school. This will certainly relieve the parents from engaging private tutors.

From Standard I upward a very comprehensive teaching plan is made and strictly followed by the qualified teachers. At the beginning of a new academic year subject-wise syllabuses and scheme for students are prepared beforehand. The syllabuses are divided into several quarters according to round-the-year exam program. The teachers in accordance with the prepared lesson-plans inculcate lessons to the students. Besides, regular class-teaching, class-test, class-work and home-work are carried out at regular intervals before each semester exam as well as final semester exam.

Monitoring cell

Recently a Monitoring Cell has started functioning in full swing under the close supervision of the head of the cell. This cell monitors overall activities of the teaching staff in respect of ensuring academic advancement as well as upholding general discipline. The head of the cell has been made responsible to look into the matters like class performance of the teachers, checking the lesson plans, examining C.W & H.W copies, going through the diaries of the students, checking the examined answer scripts, over viewing question papers before making final and giving necessary suggestions for achieving desired standard in all respects. The head of the cell plays the role of the counselor for the teachers so that they can overcome their drawbacks and lapses and can get themselves fully involved in

the profession in the true sense of the term. Monitoring cell puts every effort with a view to maintaining congenial atmosphere and establishing sound relation among the teachers themselves and among the teachers and the students as well.

The Academic Plan

Maintenance of academic standard and academic discipline is the touchstone of any educational institution. The reputation of a school largely depends on a well planned academic program and its proper implementation.

The two major objectives of the curriculum of East-West International School & College curriculum has been carefully designed to provide the students with communication skills, knowledge of our own social and cultural foundation, a major course of study with applied skills and pragmatic values and ongoing knowledge stream of the present world.

Admission Procedure

Subject to availability of seats, students seeking admission into different levels must meet the minimum educational requirements, go through an admission test, obtain admission form from the admin office, complete admission formalities and pay all required fees before getting final admission.

Parents and authorized guardians shall sign an undertaking certificate to the effect that their children/wards shall abide by the rules and regulations of East-West International School & College in force or to be framed or incorporated by the school authority from time to time. The final selection for admission will be based on students' previous school records, marks obtained in admission test and their suitability judged by the admission

committee. No admission test, however, is necessary for admission in Play Group and Nursery classes. The students willing to be admitted in Play Group, Nursery, KG and all other classes are required to ensure their fresh admission from 01 October onward for the next academic session. But afterwards, admission remains open from May to July as academic session covers from July to June.

Collection of Admission Form

Admission forms for all classes are available in the school office on all working days. Students seeking admission shall apply in the prescribed form duly filled up along with transfer-certificate, previous school-report, marks-sheet, receipt-book and three copies stamp size photographs.

School Fees

The students or their respective guardians should pay their tuition & other fees in local currency. School fees vary from class to class. Students who want to leave school after half term have to pay the full term fees. If they leave earlier, half terms fees will be charged. Guardians are earnestly requested to intimate the school authority in advance if they like to withdraw their children for the convenience of the school authority.

Scholarship / Financial Assistance

Financial concession in the form of full/half tuition waiver will be given to meritorious but financially handicapped students on the basis of class performance and year-wise results of the final examination.

Payment of Fees

A special booth has been arranged with Premier Bank, Rokeya Sarani Branch for the payment of students' tuition fees and

others charges. Fees are to be paid within 10th day of the current month. Payment of the fees after due date will require prior approval from the school authority.

Fines for the late payment of school fees are as follows:

Fees paid within the calendar month Tk. 50/-

Fees paid in the next calendar month Tk. 100/-

After two months non-payment of fees, the student's name will be deleted from the school's Admission Register Book. Under these circumstances re-admission is required subject to availability of space.

School Uniform

Students must wear school uniform when they are in the school campus and as and when directed by school authority. School dress should be collected from the school office/store on payment basis. School dress/uniform for boys and girls will be as follows:

For Boys:

- Summer (March-October): White T shirt + Navy blue gabardine pant (Full or half)
- Winter (November-February): White full shirt with school monogram + navy blue jeans pant (Full or half) with tie + navy blue sweater.
- Shoes: Oxford black shoes (Bata) with white shocks.

For Girls:

- Summer (March*-October):PG-Std IV: White T shirt + nave blue gabardine skirt.
- Std V –Upward: Navy blue kamij + white pajama + white orna with school monogram.
- Winter (November-February): PG-Std IV: Navy blue jeans skirt + white full shirt with school monogram + navy blue sweater + bow tie
- Std V-Upward: Navy blue kamij+white pajama+white orna with wchool monogram+navy blue sweater.

Shoes: Oxford black shoes (Bata) with white shocks.

Students are obliged to dress up in proper uniform during the school hours. School uniform may be ordered in the school administrative office and it must be made as per the sample approved by the school authority.

Class Timing for Morning & Day shift

At present East-West International School & College has both morning and day shift for the students of play group & nursery and only one shift for the students of K.G I to O'level. Timings for different shifts and classes are appended below:

Play group and Nursery (Morning Shift) : 08.30 a.m to 10.30 a.m

Play group and Nursery (Day Shift) : 11.00 a.m to 01.00 p.m

Kindergarten (K.G I & K.G II) : 8.30 a.m to 12.10 p.m

Standard I to O'level: 08.30 a.m to 01.30 p.m

Transport

The students staying at a reasonable distance from the school are provided with transport facilities. Transport facilities cover Dhaka city area only. Transports of the school ply through the main roads only and stop at some specified places. Transport fees are fixed depending on distance from the school. Special consideration is offered to two or more students coming from the same family. Transport charges for two months must be paid in advance during the time of admission. Students to be picked up from residence shall have to pay eight hundred taka per month.

Attendance and Punctuality

Students' regular attendance is considered as an obligatory part of the school. The authority may excuse only three absences with acceptable reasons. Permission from the principal is required in advance to remain absent in three or more consecutive days for reasons justified (e.g illness). Long and deliberate absences may lead to charging fine or striking off the

students' name from the class register and will then require re-admission to continue classes. Students are required to attend all workshops, seminars, debates, school/national ceremonies or other officially organized activities. Failure to do so will reflect on the conduct sheet of the students. Late attendance will be penalized. Habitual late comers may be charged with late fine or shall lose his/her registration.

Duration of Semester

Duration of each semester will normally be 18 weeks which may be broken down as follows:

Marks Distribution

The total performance of a student in a particular course is based on a skim of continuous assessments. For theoretical courses this continuous assessment is made through home work, assignments, attendance and quizzes etc. of a mid semester and a final semester examination of 2 or 3 hours duration. The distribution of marks for a class is given as follows:

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Grading

EWISC maintains the international standard and follows a Letter Grading System comprising the grades A, B, C, D to qualify the overall performance of a student where a student must require to have a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA of at least 'B').

Recognition of Outstanding Performance

East-West International School & College encourages students to strive for achieving excellence in all co-curricular activities and recognizes outstanding academic performance by honors, awards and prizes. The Chairman's Medal is awarded annually to the students who can show excellence in overall performance.



Co-curricular Activities

Co-curricular activities are considered as integral parts of a modern education system. Recognizing this imperative, East-West International School & College intends to provide facilities for such activities, which will help develop a well-groomed, responsible and self-disciplined individual. East-West International School & College undertakes programs with active involvement of students to sharpen intellectual qualities through inter-school debates, cultural activities and other creative pursuits. Provisions have been made for both indoor and outdoor games. Such informal interaction between students and teachers under the aegis of our highly qualified and experienced teachers helps the students grow up mentally and physically balanced.

Academic Discipline and Offence

Maintenance of academic standard and reputation is a joint responsibility of the students and the school authority. The basic requirement for development and acquisition of knowledge is intellectual honesty. If a student is found to have committed academic offences-such as cheating in examinations, abetting cheating, impersonating in an examination, misrepresenting of information, forging of academic records and behaving rudely with teachers, he or she will be given a “F” grade in the examination and even warrant dismissal.

Holiday

The East-West International School & College remains closed on Friday and Saturday. The institution also observes the public holidays strictly.

Students Identity Card

All the students of East-West International School & College get laminated identity cards where their stamp size photograph remain fixed. The students are required to display this card while he/she is in the school premises, attending classes and using the Library and Computer Lab.

Office of Admin Officer

An Administrative Officer with the help of experienced staff administers the office. The admin office provides information about all programs. The office arranges and carries out all activities related to admission, registration, welfare of the students etc.

School Library

East-West International School & College library offers many facilities to aid the students' academic career; they are welcome to use the services of the library. Copies of test books and the reference books and course handouts are available in the library. The East-West International School & College library has all the important national dailies, magazines, journals and reference books. The library is run by a well-experienced librarian to serve the East-West International School & College students' needs.

School Cafeteria

East-West International School & College has a well furnished and hygienic cafeteria in the ground floor for the students where soft drinks and snacks are available at the modest rate.

Medical service

A Medical Officer is available to look after the health of the students. He ensures overall salutary atmosphere of the East-

West International School & College through medical cheek-up and providing primary knowledge on health care.

Students Counseling Centre

There is a counseling centre to help and guide the students who face problems of any emotional and psychological nature. There is also a Student Welfare Officer to look after the needs of the students.

Computer Lab

East-West International School & College has a well-equipped computer lab staffed by a Professional System Manager and Lab Assistant. Students can utilize computers as a part of supervised class and at their own to complete assignment.

A full day schooling and residential facility

A. East-West International School & College helps the students to express the feelings and thoughts even by stimulation their imagination and creative power. The overwhelming feeling today is that our education system has become largely divorced from the realities of modern life. Our aim and Endeavour will be to provide a full day schooling education. It will serve the needs of life, society and parental love.

We have launched out into full-day schooling facilities in consideration for the busy and working mother. Due to engagement in professions, mothers are unable to provide ample and affable motherly-love, care, observation etc. We are helpful to give necessary care and time to their children. We are providing Mental Trait Amelioration Lesson (MTAL)

to the children under the well-experienced teaching staff. The main advantages of this system are:

- i. Students remain in the school premises up to 5.00 p.m. with utmost care and flawless security.
- ii. Students remain free from the influence of “maid-servant culture”. Personality will not be cramped being influenced by the traditional way of thinking.
- iii. Congenial atmosphere is ensured to become well oriented with the retention of educative and intellectual faculties of students.
- iv. Students are nurtured under the direct care and supervision of a well experienced and friendly child psychologist who ensures the psychological development, educational enlightenment as well as appropriate nurturing of the students.
- v. Students are provided nutritious & hygienic lunch. Lots of funs and games are supplied for students to keep them engaged.
- vi. Students finish their lessons including home-work under the guidance of qualified teachers. No extra tuition fee be needed for the house tutors.
- vii. Continuous effort is in practice to enhance students’ English conversational knack and dexterity through full time English communication.

B. In addition to full day care and schooling East-West International School & College is extending board and lodging facilities to the students who want to study at this school as resident students. The school authority takes up the total responsibilities of the students desirous of prosecuting studies in any form or class at this institute. The parents and guardians living in Bangladesh or abroad will be guaranteed safety, security and academic progress of their children admitted as resident students. Additional employees and officials are there to look after the boarders round the clock. Hygienic living condition, standard and nutritious foods prepared in its own kitchen are provided to

the resident students. For resident students, boarding and lodging charges will be different but reasonable and within the reach of the guardians.

Boarding / Residence shall run on the following system

- a. A student once admitted as a resident student in any class will have to stay in the boarding house round the clock throughout an academic session.
- b. An academic session (a full year) will be usually divided into $\frac{3}{4}$ working terms. Each working term will be followed by an examination and vacations-summer vacation, winter vacation, Ramadan/Eid vacation. The resident students are allowed to go back home to spend holidays with parents. On the expiry of vacation they will report back to boarding house a day before the school reopens to give them a settling time.
- c. During holiday consisting of a day or two or less than half a week the resident students are not allowed to go home instead they will stay back in their school residence. However, parents/legal guardians living nearby the boarding house may take their children / words during short holiday with a written permission from the house master/hostel super.
- d. Parents Day – Parents and legal guardians will be allowed to see their children in the boarding house premises once in a week (Friday/Saturday) within a time fixed by the authority.
- e. On working days during a term, resident students will not be granted leave except on serious or urgent ground such as grave illness of parents and own family members. Leave will not be granted on the ground of ordinary social function, or on occasion like birthday or marriage ceremony of distant relatives.
- f. In case of a resident student falling sick, medical attendance shall be at once made available. Besides, the concerned parents/guardians will be informed of the matter as soon as possible. The anxious parents may be allowed to take their ailing child for treatment at home. In case of a resident student

suffering from any contagious or infectious disease, his/her parents will be informed to take him/her home to prevent the spread of the disease among other resident students.

g. Resident students will follow a separate daily schedule showing their bed-out to bed-in activities including common academic program along with daily-schedule.

h. All resident students shall discharge strict sense of discipline as long as they will reside here. They must try to live up to the trust and expectation of the school authority. The school authority will also take care of the boarders to fulfill the desired hopes of the parents / guardians.

i. All resident students shall have to abide by the rules and regulations imposed by the authority. This will be required to lead a descent and trouble free life in the boarding house. The code of discipline is laid down as follows:

- They should behave well, show respect to rules and regulations and act upon them sincerely and without grudge. They should carry out the orders and instructions of the official; remain ever loyal to residential motto and ideology.
- They must follow the daily schedules religiously and strictly, cooperate and live in harmony with fellow residents as well as other residents of the boarding house/dormitories.
- While the junior students shall show proper respect to the seniors, the latter should be affectionate and considerate to the juniors.
- An exemplary decency and good manners will always be expected from them.
- They must refrain from quarrelling, cheating, teasing, fighting and exchanging bad and abusive language with one another.
- To look smart they will always put on clean and well-washed school or personal dress and at the same time must

keep their bed, cupboard and book-shelf clean and well arranged.

- While taking meals in the dining room they must demonstrate table manners, talk in a low voice and behave nicely with the kitchen staff.
- They must love and take care of residence they live in. Not only their own things but also all things belong to the residence should be treated as their own. Any damage of school property will not be tolerated and the defaulter shall have to compensate the loss.
- Last but not the least is the careful use of toilets/bathrooms. Your test, your habit and your hygienic outlook will all depend on how you use them. Everybody wants to see them neat and clean and non-stinky, as you do. As such, it will be needed for every user to keep them spick and span.
- To keep in touch with your dear parents and to inform them quite regularly how you are, and how you are carrying on with your studies, you will write nice letters to them at least once in a week.

Offences and Punishment

Any violation of rules and instructions stated above would be treated as great offence and depending on the degree and type of offence committed by the student, punishment will be awarded.

Facilities for Resident Students

The school authority will provide the following items to the resident students free of cost:

Wooden cot; wooden/steel locker to keep personal belongings ; wooded / plastic book-self; table and chair; indoor games items.

The school authority will also provide the following on payment: school uniform along with neck tie; books and stationery; breakfast; lunch; dinner.
